- Planning with the six synods of Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan for the Lutheran Office of Public Policy's Youth Advocacy Retreat for high school and college-age students in October

- Helping restructure and redefine the Synod Youth Ministry Team
- Sharing resources and information for those working with young people in our congregations
