
## What Can We Do?



## Mosquitoes and Malaria

Mosquitoes live in the United States AND in Africa. It doesn't matter where you live: mosquitoes and people do NOT get along. Have you ever had a mosquito bite? How does it feel? It itches, doesn't it?

Musa, Amani and Ngozi itch when they get mosquito bites, too. But there is something worse for people who live in Africa. Mosquitoes in Africa carry a terrible sickness called **malaria**. When these children get a mosquito bite, they can get very sick. Some children in Africa even die from malaria.

In Africa, the mosquitoes that carry malaria come out at night. Families can protect themselves from mosquito bites and malaria by sleeping under a **bed net** that keeps the mosquitoes away. Connect the dots so that Amani's family sleeps under a bed net.
