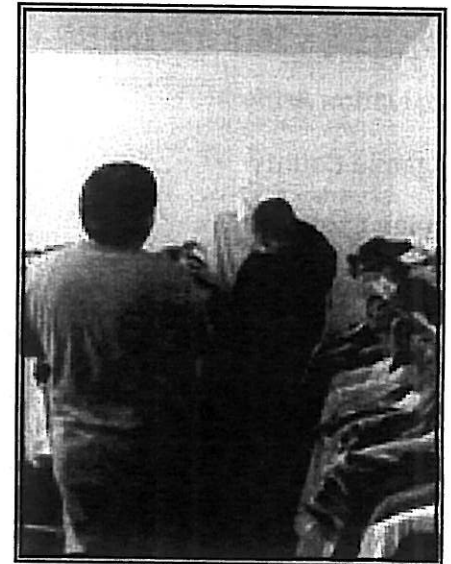

How Does It Work?

Each client needs a referral from any of the following agencies:

- LEAVEN
- The Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley
- The Salvation Army
- Outagamie County
- Warming Shelter
- Appleton Public Schools
- And other agencies



All clothing is brand new. Donations have been received by the following:

- Members of Zion Lutheran Church and other area churches
- Thrivent
- Various clothing manufacturers and stores
- Various grants

Point Values

Each client receives 25 points twice a year as referred. Point values and maximum quantities for each item are as follows:

- 1 point (Accessories, underwear, socks with 2 max.)
- 2 points (Bras, hats, gloves, scarves with 2 max.)
- 3 Points (Tops, Shirts with 5 max.)
- 4 Points (Pajamas, Robes, Sweaters, Fleece, Swimsuits, Shoes, Slippers, Onesies with 1 max)
- 5 Points (Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Dresses, Blazers, Jackets with 2 max.)
- 7 Points (Winter Coats with 1 max.)

If clients do not use all 25 points in their first visit, they may return within 6 months to use the remaining points.

After 6 months, each client needs another referral from a qualifying agency.
