

After weeks of getting ready, hanging up clothing, arranging by size, and organizing



the stock, the doors opened. Through the support of Zion members, Thrivent, the Appleton Conference, and other friends & family, Disciples' Closet is thriving. Donations of clothing & money, along with the clothing left by our predecessor, Urban Thread, Disciples' closet has been able to clothe 309 people to date. This includes 177 adults and 132 children. Our referring agencies so far

include The Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley, LEAVEN, Salvation Army, Harbor House, various departments of Outagamie County, Appleton Area School District, and Zion Lutheran Church. There is a dedicated crew of volunteers who come faithfully to serve the clients and continue to keep the racks filled with season appropriate clothing. Tracking the number of volunteer hours served began in February and total 379."
