- 61 pounds of banana peppers valued at \$95.77.
- 528 pounds of cucumbers valued at \$1,631.52.
- 97 pounds of carrots valued at \$185.27.
- 85 pounds of bell peppers valued at \$133.45.
- 189 pounds of zucchini valued at \$285.39.
- 17 pounds of cayenne peppers valued at

\$26.69.

- 100 pounds of onions valued at \$141.00.
- 145 pounds of green beans valued at \$303.05.
- 48 pounds of radishes valued at \$60.48.
- 132 pounds of beets valued at \$166.32.
