Each week that money came in we took down that amount of mosquitoes. People made contributions through offerings, and at our Lenten Soup Suppers, and Sunday School classes donating change. In no time, the 100 mosquitoes were gone. In fact, we received double what our goal was! \$2,000.00 was raised. We were thrilled by this effort and response from the members.
